Safety on the Road Day

The Sharjah Desert Park welcomed the FS1 and FS2 students on February 18th and 27th with trips to the different sites like the Arabian wildlife and the children's farm. The Wildlife Centre houses the world's largest collection of Arabian wildlife and is the only zoological park in the Middle East that is completely indoors. The students welcomed the opportunity to be able to see the animals in their natural habitat.

The Wildlife Centre houses a wide variety of species inclusive of reptiles, birds, nocturnal animals, ungulates and large carnivores. The visit to the Sharjah Desert Park ensured a lively group discussion and evoked wonder-eyed questions for the teachers for quite a few days at hand.
